On 15 January 2015, the Agencia Nacional de Evaluación de la Calidad y de la Acreditación [National Agency for Quality Assessment and Accreditation or ANECA according to its initials in Spanish] produced the report for the establishment of the correspondence of the degree of Ingeniero de Caminos, Canales y Puertos. In this report it is stated that the university degree leads to regulated profession and it is concluded that the official degree of Ingeniero de Caminos, Canales y Puertos corresponds to level 3 of MECES (Máster level).
- 4. On 23 February 2015, the Directorate General of University Policy agreed to open the public information process of this administrative procedure. ------
- 5. On 9 March 2015, the opening of the public information process was published on the Official State Bulletin. The file was submitted to the process of public information between 10 March and 4 April 2015. ------
